Getting to and from Caesars Palace and the airport is approximately 20 minutes and an average cost of \$35 by Taxi Cab.

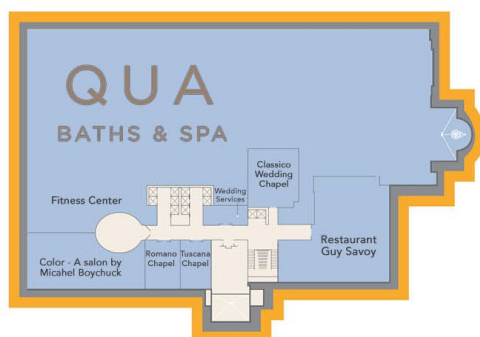
Caesar's Palace Property Map

Continuing Medical Education (CME) Information
